

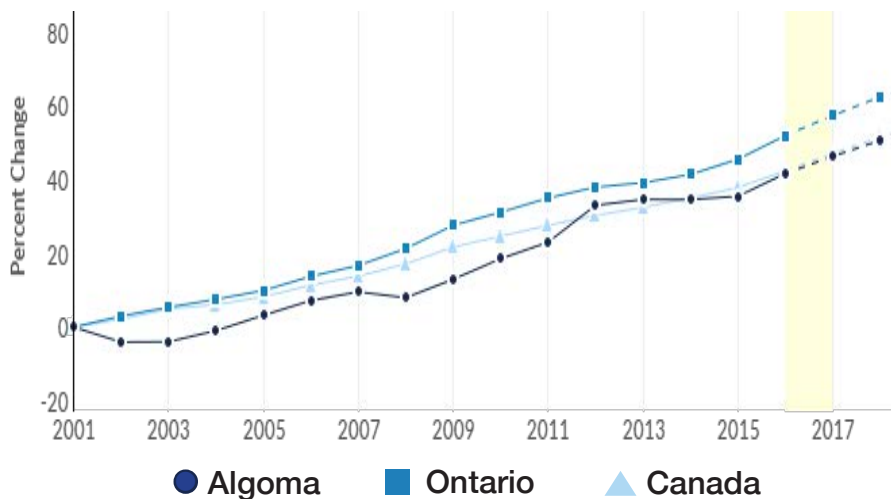
HEALTHCARE & SOCIAL ASSISTANCE NAIC 62

Healthcare and Social Assistance in Algoma

This sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in providing healthcare by diagnosis and treatment, providing residential care for medical and social reasons, and providing social assistance, such as counseling, welfare, child protection, community housing and food services, vocational rehabilitation and child care, to those requiring such assistance.

The Healthcare and Social Assistance sector is the largest employer in the district of Algoma. It supports approximately 8,288 jobs which is 17% of all jobs in the District. There are 615 registered business (employers) in the sector ranging from large employers such as Hospitals to individuals offering Ambulatory health care services.
