








#### JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR ALGOMA REGION


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?


#### NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




#### AVG & MEDIAN POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS





# JOB TYPE Full-time vs Part-time




#### **JOB DURATION**

Permanency of jobs posted










