




How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?


NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




AVERAGE POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS






DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (ALGOMA & UNORGANIZED NORTH)

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?














DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (ALGOMA & UNORGANIZED NORTH)




















JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
