


#### NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




#### AVERAGE POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS

How long are employers having to recruit for to find candidates to fill their job vacancies?











## **DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (ALGOMA & UNORGANIZED NORTH)**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?















#### **DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (ALGOMA & UNORGANIZED NORTH)**
















#### **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
